



Parent and Student Participation Agreement

Please complete the Dragons Participation Agreement form at the bottom of this document.

Section 1 Certification of Physical Condition

My signature (at the bottom of this form) is to certify that my son/daughter is physically fit enough to participate in the activities he/she is trying out for.

Section 2 Permission to Participate

My signature (at the bottom of this form) indicates that my son/daughter has permission to participate in the GIS Dragons Programme as a member of an athletic team. The school is not liable for injuries incurred while the student is participating in the athletic programme or the cost of medical care resulting from any injuries.

I release Garden International School and its representatives from responsibility for all costs on my behalf and I give permission for the above named student to receive immediate medical attention by a suitably qualified medical professional while the student is in attendance at an athletic contest or practice.

I also understand that my son/daughter's athletic involvement requires that they will travel by bus to and from competitions and will be dismissed from either the competition venue or from within school grounds.

Section 3 Permission To Travel

Additionally, if chosen to represent GIS on a traveling team at one of the season's major tournaments, I agree (by the signature on the bottom of this form) to do my best to allow my son/ daughter to travel with the team and I will pay the full cost of the trip (RM amount confirmed on a trip by trip basis).

Section 4 Uniform

Each athlete at GIS will be responsible for school kit and in some cases may have to purchase a uniform to compete for a team. The coach at the beginning of the season will inform their players of the cost of the uniform, if there is any charge to the athlete and any other equipment needed to participate.

Section 5 GIS' Athletic Code

1. **Student Conduct and Behaviour:** Athletes are expected to demonstrate personal integrity. They must abide by all rules set out by the School, ISAC, SEASAC, FOBISIA.
2. **Personal Health:** The use of tobacco products, illegal drugs and alcohol are harmful to athletic performance. Any athlete caught using harmful substances at any school-sponsored activity (including all sport trips, home games or practices, field trips or other school functions) will be immediately removed from that team for the remainder of the season.
3. **Eligibility:** The athlete must meet all requirements set forth by GIS regarding academic eligibility. Note that an athlete must be in "Good Academic Standing" if he/she is to play for a team.
4. **Attendance:** Attendance at all practices and games is **mandatory** unless permission is given by the coach to miss a session.
 - a. Athletes are expected in school on days of games, trips, and the day after returning home from an athletic trip.

- b. Students who repeatedly fail to demonstrate commitment to the team and all other members of the team (i.e. late or frequently absent for practice) may be suspended or removed from the team.
 - c. Students should make every effort to schedule appointments (i.e. tutorials/medical) outside of team practice times and competitions. Also, injured players are still required to attend each practice/game the team holds unless permission to miss has been secured from the coach.
5. If a student participates on a team/club outside of school, they must still attend 2 sessions each week to be eligible to participate on a GIS team. The required number of sessions may vary from activity to activity but once agreed by TIC, Coach and Ambassador at the start of the season must be adhered to.
6. **After a violation occurs;**
- a. The incident will be treated by GIS as an in-school offense.
 - b. The athlete's parents will be informed and may be called in for a meeting if warranted
 - c. The athlete may be removed/suspended from the team
 - d. The athlete may be liable to disciplinary action as deemed necessary by the Athletics Director and the Head of School. The athlete will, at the very least, be on probation for a one year period. Any violations of the Athletic Code during that time will be cause for a one year suspension from participation in any athletic events.

Section 6 Use of Photos

I give permission to the school to use sport photos of my son/daughter on the school's website and other electronic and print publications.

I understand and accept that these guidelines and procedures are the rules governing the student-athlete during the time of participation, commencing with the first try-out and continuing until the conclusion of the season.

In the interests of being a "Green School" we have decided to **avoid** a print and sign style and go for a **google form** instead.
